

# Chris Burke's Patent History

## Impressive history



- Founded in Hong Kong in the 2000's
- Quickly grew a patent portfolio and then manufacturing business
- Distribution to over 1M users

2003

- Chris Burke understood the necessity for access / credit card security and began patenting his ideas



- 2006 several patents completed focusing on mobile computing device security with biometrics
- 2008 first Wiegand Access keyfob production and global sales commenced, reaching over 1M users

- 2008 Chris Burke received approval for more patents, including biometrics activation of access card technologies and integration with OTP One Time Password
- 2020 More patents were submitted combining health credentials with biometrics security

- 2003 Chris Burke started patenting his ideas
- 2008 Manufacturing commenced to showcase the patents, mobile biometrics
- 2012 Apple introduced the iPhone 5 with biometrics activation and security
- 2013 Smartphone technology from ALL manufacturers included biometrics activation
- 2014 laptops and other devices incorporated biometrics
- 2015 fingerprints, facial, iris, palm and other biometrics technologies started to proliferate
- 2016 passwords are increasingly obsolete
- 2020 pandemic required enhanced online security

Chris Burke has consistently been able to understand technological market requirements and has single-handedly created an impressive patent portfolio, which continues to grow and expand
